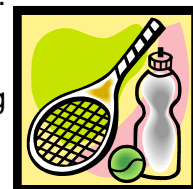

There you go, the words of a champion. Congratulations Charlize!

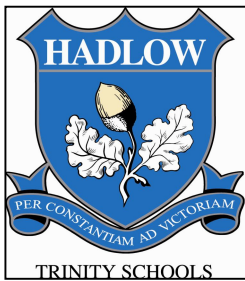
